

**Trail Ride at Yorktown Stirrup Club**  
**Located on the Naval Weapons Station Yorktown**  
**Sunday, November 19, 2006**

**BY PRE-REGISTRATION ONLY**

**Deadline for registration must be postmarked by November 13, 2006**

You are invited to enjoy the beautiful scenery and lovely woods in an 8-10 mile trail ride with our Stirrup Club. All breeds and riding styles are welcome to participate. We have trails for the beginning rider as well as some challenging trails for the more advanced.

Since our club is located on the Naval Weapons Station, there are certain guidelines we must follow for security reasons. Every person attending the event must pre-register by mail by the above deadline. All persons attending, both riders and non-riders must complete a registration form and Release of Liability. You must be a United States citizen in order to enter the base. When you check in at the first checkpoint at Gate 3, you must have in your possession: a valid photo ID (driver's license, student ID, etc) for each person in the vehicle, current registration and proof of insurance for your vehicle.

There is a Facility User Fee of \$20.00 per rider to help us maintain our trails. Lunches are available for an extra \$5.00 per person. Please make checks out to Yorktown Stirrup Club and include it with your registration fee. There is a returned check fee of \$25.00.

**No refunds after November 13.**

Check-in time at Gate 3 is between 8:00 am and 10:00 am. Please remember to bring your vehicle registration and insurance cards! Allow some extra time for possible vehicle searches at the gate. All guests must depart the base by 4:00 pm.

**NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED IN VEHICLES MOVING ON THE BASE. NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED ON THE TRAILS. YOU MAY SMOKE ONLY IN YOUR VEHICLE PARKED AT THE EVENT AND ALL BURNING MATERIALS AND DEBRIS MUST STAY INSIDE THE VEHICLE.**

At the second checkpoint, you must show a current negative Coggins report. Certified ASTM helmets are required for all riders under 18 and encouraged for all. Riders under 18 must ride with a supervising adult.

## **Directions**

From Norfolk, VA—Take I-64 west to Yorktown/Lee Hall exit 247. Veer right off the exit and turn left at the light onto Jefferson Ave/Rte 143 (At the 7-Eleven). Gate 3 will be on your right after about 1 mile.

From Richmond, VA—Take I-64 east to Yorktown/Lee Hall exit 247. Turn left off exit onto Jefferson Ave/Rte. 143. Gate 3 will be on your left after about 1 mile.

From Gloucester, VA—Take Route 17 south to York County across the Coleman Bridge. About 1 mile after the Coleman Bridge, turn right onto Goosley Rd/Rte 238. Continue until you come to a “T” intersection. Turn left onto Old Williamsburg Rd/Rte/238. You will pass Gate 1 at the first light. You may not enter this gate. Go to the second traffic light (at the 7-Eleven) and turn right onto Jefferson Ave/Rte 143. Gate 3 will be on your right after about 1 mile.

From Suffolk, VA via the ferry—Take 460 to Wakefield. Turn right at the light onto Hwy 31. About a quarter of a mile down, the road makes a left turn. *Be careful to follow the signs and stay on Hwy 31. If you go straight, you will end up lost in the country!* Stay on Hwy 31 through Dendron, and Surry and to the ferry. When you exit the ferry, stay on Hwy 31 to the next stoplight. Take Hwy 199 to I-64 east. Use I-64 east to Yorktown/Lee Hall exit 247. Turn left of the exit onto Jefferson Ave/Rte 143. Gate 3 will be on your left after about 1 mile.

Once you are on the base, there will be signs to the event. Checkpoint #2 will be at the parking area for the event. Your Coggins paperwork will be checked and you will be given a trail map and information and lunch tickets here. Once you are ready to leave on your ride, check out with the Time Keeper. Check in with the Time Keeper when you return.  
No dogs please. No stallions please.
